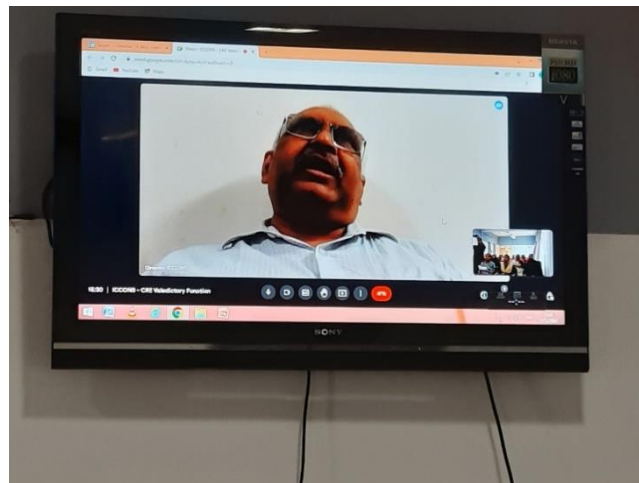
The session was started by the Resource Persons on their individual sub-topics which were based on the CRE main topic. Followed by each session, there was discussion and question-answer session.
